#### **INTRODUCTION**

Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH) is a premier Mental Health Institute in Northeast India. The Institution was established in the year 1876 and is recognized as one of the oldest centers providing quality mental health care and treatment.

The Institute is mandated to be a tertiary care institute of Mental Health & Neurosciences and it is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

Regular academic course in the Institute started in the year 2001 with the introduction of one year Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing (DPN). DNB in Psychiatry was started in the year 2006. This was followed by the M. Sc Nursing (Psychiatric Nursing) in 2007; M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work in 2009, M.D (Psychiatry) in 2010 and M. Phil in Medical and Social Psychology in 2011 which was later renamed as M. Phil in Clinical Psychology from 2014. The Ph.D. programme in Psychiatric Social Work (PSW) and Psychiatric Nursing was started in October 2017. The Ph.D. program in Clinical Psychology was started in 2020. Masters in Medical Laboratory Sciences (MMLS) in department of Clinical Biochemistry, Hematology & Blood Banking and Medical Microbiology has been introduced from 2021. The courses of the institute are affiliated to Gauhati University and recognized by the National Medical Commission-Medical Counseling Committee / Rehabilitation Council of India / Indian Nursing Council. The Institute has also started various PDF/ Fellowships / Certificate courses. The courses are designed to serve the specific needs of the country in general and the north-eastern region in particular to develop the field of mental health.

The Institute provides patient care services by a multidisciplinary team of mental health professionals with the basic objective of providing equitable access to quality psychiatric care to all sections of the society and thus reducing the global burden of diseases. It also takes numerous initiatives for promotion of positive mental health in the country and reduces the stigma and prejudice associated in this field.

#### GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP / FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMS

Age: Maximum 45 years (on the last day of submission of application). Relaxable for in-service sponsored candidates as per rule.

#### **Emoluments**

*For Post Doctoral Fellowship* Institute stipendiary: Basic pay of ₹67,700/- (Level 11) per month

<mark>For Fellowship</mark>

Institute Stipendiary: Basic pay of ₹25,000/- per month

#### For Sponsored Candidates

Applicants selected under 'Sponsorship Candidates' in both the Postdoctoral fellowship and fellowship programs who are drawing pay and allowances from their employers are not eligible for any emoluments from the institute.

#### Selection

Selection test will be conducted for open category of seat & will be notified accordingly.

## **RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR ALL COURSES**

Reservation will be followed as per Government of India norms.

Candidates who are seeking reservation benefit in the OBC category should submit a certificate as per DOPT O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res) dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2017. *The issuing date of OBC* (*NCL*) certificate must not be older than a year up to the closing date for submission of online application form.

Candidates, who are seeking reservation benefit in the EWS category, should submit a certificate as per DOPT O.M. No 36039/1/2019-Esst (Res) dated 31/01/2019.

There will be reservation of seats for each of the North Eastern Region (NER) states based on rolling roster method. The deputed/sponsored candidates are required to produce a No-Objection-Certificate (NOC) or a letter of award of deputation or sponsorship, from respective State Govt. at the time of Counseling.

## **STIPEND/FELLOWSHIP**

Stipend per month for non-deputed candidates will be as per Institute rules. **Candidates whoare on deputation/sponsored from respective states will not be paid any stipend from the Institute.** Candidates claiming seat based on JRF or other fellowships, are not eligible for Institute stipend. Fees payable to the institute for the various programmes per annum, is given below:

In addition to the above,

- 1. The Enrolment fees, Eligibility Fees, Registration Fees and Examination Fees have to be paid to the affiliating University / State Nursing Council from *time to time* as per norms after admission.
- 2. Caution money & hostel deposit will be refunded on release of the scholars /students.

## **DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES**

#### A) Conditions for Leaving the Course

All the **scholars/ trainees/students** have to abide by the conditions of the **Bond Agreement. It is required that a penalty** amount be paid in the event of discontinuation of the course after final admission (as per MCC norms) of the candidate through NEET PG counseling for MD Psychiatry course.

Scholars and trainees of other courses (stipendiary/sponsored/ external stipendiary holders/ fellowship holders) will have to abide by the bond agreement for discontinuation from the course including payment of penalty amount for causing loss of seat. Payment of penalty is not applicable if the scholar or trainee discontinues from the course within fifteen days (15) from the date of admission. The 15 days provision is not applicable for MD Psychiatry admission.

#### **B)** Disqualification from Continuing the Course

The scholar/ trainee will be declared disqualified from continuing the course under the following circumstances –

- i. Any form of misconduct with any patient/patient relative/faculty member / staff.
- ii. If disqualification is suggested by a disciplinary committee.
- iii. If the **scholar/trainee** does not appear in the examination for 03(Three) consecutive times.
- iv. Submission of false documents or concealing relevant information.
- v. If the **scholar/ trainee** does not follow the rules and regulations of the Institute and concerned regulating bodies.
- vi. **Scholar/trainee** once expelled from the Institute will be disqualified to appear in any examination in LGBRIMH in the future.
- vii. The matter of absence for more than one month will be dealt as per institute norms.

## **LEAVE MATTERS**

- All leave must be pre-sanctioned.
- **Scholars /trainees** must inform the respective Head of the Departments for leave and to get approval prior to proceeding on leave.
- M.D. students: First Year: 30 days and Second and Third Year 36 days in a completed academic year. (As per residency scheme adopted by the institute)
- M. Sc./Ph.D. Nursing (Psychiatric Nursing), Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing, Masters in Medical Laboratory Sciences (MMLS), M. Phil/Ph.D. in Psychiatric Social Work and M. Phil/Ph.D in Clinical Psychology, are eligible for thirty (30) days of leave per year.

## **DATE OF JOINING**

Selected candidates must join the course, after paying the necessary fees on or before the dates stipulated, failing which the selection shall automatically stand cancelled. The institute shall offer such seats to the candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

Ragging is totally prohibited at LGBRIMH, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, is liable to be punished appropriately.

## SUBMISSION OF AFFIDAFIT ON RAGGING
