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Section I: About the Institute

Introduction

Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH) is a premier mental health institute in North East India. The Institution was established in the year 1876 and is recognised as one of the oldest centres providing quality mental health care and treatment.

With a legacy of nearly 150 years, LGBRIMH is among India's oldest mental health institutions and serves as a premier tertiary mental health referral, training and academic centre for the North Eastern Region under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

The Institute is mandated to be a tertiary care institute of mental health and neurosciences and is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.

Vision: *To advance mental health, neurosciences, rehabilitation, education and research for the North Eastern Region and the nation.*

Academic Growth Timeline

Regular academic courses started in 2001 with the Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing (DPN). DNB in Psychiatry was introduced in 2006, followed by M.Sc. Nursing (Psychiatric Nursing) in 2007, M.Phil. in Psychiatric Social Work in 2009, M.D. (Psychiatry) in 2010, and M.Phil. in Medical and Social Psychology in 2011 (renamed as M.Phil. in Clinical Psychology in 2014). Ph.D. programmes in Psychiatric Social Work and Psychiatric Nursing commenced in October 2017; Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology in 2020. Masters in Medical Laboratory Sciences (MMLS) was introduced in 2021.

The M.Phil. programme in Clinical Psychology is proposed to be offered as Masters in Clinical Psychology (M.Clin.Psy.), and the M.Phil. programme in Psychiatric Social Work is proposed to be offered as Masters in Psychiatric Social Work (M.PSW), from 2026-27 onwards, subject to approval/recognition/affiliation by the competent regulatory bodies and Gauhati University. Programmes in Psychiatric Social Work and Medical Laboratory Sciences shall be governed by the applicable norms of Gauhati University, NCAHP / Assam Allied Healthcare Council and the Institute, wherever applicable.

All reservations including PwBD (Persons with Benchmark Disabilities) will be as per Government of India Policy. PwBD reservation shall operate horizontally as per Government of India norms. Candidates claiming PwBD benefit must produce a valid benchmark disability certificate from the competent authority and shall be subject to medical board/course-specific suitability requirements prescribed by the relevant regulatory body.

Seats reserved for North Eastern States will be declared open if not filled by Government deputation. Reservation will be as per Government of India norms for open seats. Separate selection tests will be conducted for open category DPN seats and will be notified accordingly.

Unfilled sponsored/NER seats shall be converted only after the prescribed nomination deadline and approval of the Admission Counselling Committee/competent authority. Converted seats shall be filled as per applicable Government of India reservation norms and published vacancy notice.

Only deputed/sponsored candidates with valid documents issued by the respective State Government will be considered under the NER seat reservation category. Candidates claiming reservation under this category must qualify NEET-PG (for MD seats), GU-PGET (for Masters and M.Sc. programmes) to be eligible to appear for counselling.

Selection

A selection interview/test will be conducted for the open category of seat and will be notified accordingly.

Fellowship conditions such as selection method, interview/weightage, stipend rules, sponsored-candidate rules, leave, hostel availability, bond applicability, duties and certificate issue shall be notified separately before admission.

Section VII: Reservation, Stipend, Bond & Fee Structure

Reservation of Seats

Reservation will be followed as per Government of India norms.

- OBC Candidates: Submit certificate as per DoPT O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res) dated 13th September 2017. The issuing date of OBC (NCL) certificate must not be older than one year up to the closing date for submission of online application form.
- EWS Candidates: Submit certificate as per DoPT O.M. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt. (Res) dated 31/01/2019.

A reservation-document checklist shall be published for UR/OBC-NCL/SC/ST/EWS/PwBD/NER sponsored candidates, specifying certificate format, issuing authority, validity date, central-list requirement and consequence of invalid documents.

NER State Rolling Roster:

There will be reservation of seats for each of the North Eastern Region (NER) states based on a rolling roster method. The deputed/sponsored candidates are required to produce a No-Objection Certificate (NOC) or a letter of award of deputation or sponsorship from respective State Govt. at the time of Counselling.

The NER state-wise rolling roster shall be maintained by the Academic Office and approved by the competent authority. The current year's roster and any vacancy conversion shall be published on the Institute website before counselling.

Stipend / Fellowship

Stipend per month for non-deputed candidates will be as per Institute rules. Candidates who are on deputation/sponsored from respective states will not be paid any stipend from the Institute. Candidates claiming seat based on JRF or other fellowships are not eligible for Institute stipend.

Stipend shall be subject to attendance, satisfactory conduct, applicable deductions, availability of funds and Institute rules. Stipend rates may be revised by the competent authority and are not payable to sponsored/deputed candidates.

Bond Agreement

- Enrolment, Eligibility, Registration and Examination Fees are payable to the affiliating University / State Nursing Council from time to time as per norms after admission.
- Caution money & hostel deposit will be refunded on release of the scholars/students.

Section VIII: Rules and General Instructions

Discontinuation of Studies

Conditions for Leaving the Course

All scholars/trainees/students must abide by the conditions of the Bond Agreement. A penalty amount is payable in the event of discontinuation after final admission.

Scholars and trainees of other courses (stipendiary/sponsored/external stipendiary holders/fellowship holders) will have to abide by the bond agreement for discontinuation, including payment of penalty for causing loss of seat. Payment of penalty is not applicable if the scholar/trainee discontinues within 15 days from the date of admission. The 15-day provision is not applicable for MD Psychiatry admission.

Discontinuation procedure: the scholar/trainee shall submit a written application; the date of receipt shall determine refund/penalty implications; dues shall be cleared before release; original documents, if any, shall be returned after verification/clearance; waiver/review may be considered only by the competent authority as per rules.

Disqualification from Continuing the Course

No scholar/trainee shall be disqualified except after notice, opportunity of representation/hearing and a reasoned order by the competent authority, subject to Institute, University and regulatory body rules.

A scholar/trainee will be declared disqualified under the following circumstances:

- Any form of misconduct with any patient/patient relative/faculty member/staff.
- If disqualification is suggested by a disciplinary committee.
- If the scholar/trainee does not appear in the examination for 03 (three) consecutive times.
- Submission of false documents or concealing relevant information.
- If the scholar/trainee does not follow the rules and regulations of the Institute and concerned regulatory bodies.
- Scholar/trainee once expelled from the Institute will be disqualified to appear in any examination at LGBRIMH in the future.
- The matter of absence for more than one month will be dealt with as per Institute norms.

Leave Matters

- All leave must be pre-sanctioned.
- Scholars/trainees must inform the respective Head of Department for leave and obtain approval prior to proceeding on leave.
- M.D. students: First Year -30 days; Second and Third Year -36 days in a completed academic year (as per residency scheme adopted by the Institute).
- M.Sc./Ph.D. Nursing, DPN, MMLS, M.PSW/Ph.D. PSW and M.Clin.Psy/Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology & Post-Doctoral Fellowship/Fellowship -eligible for 30 days of leave per year.
- Eligibility to appear in the final examination for all courses will be governed by rules of Gauhati University/Regulatory body/Institute, whichever is applicable.

Leave shall be subject to minimum attendance, clinical posting, logbook, University/regulatory body and Institute requirements. Maternity, medical and duty leave shall be regulated as per applicable rules and may extend training where required.

Date of Joining

Selected candidates must join the course, after paying the necessary fees, on or before the stipulated dates, failing which the selection shall automatically stand cancelled. The Institute shall offer such seats to candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

Anti-Ragging Policy

Ragging is totally prohibited at LGBRIMH, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately.

The Anti-Ragging Affidavit formats may be downloaded through the Institute's Anti-Ragging page, available under Important Links on the website (<https://lgbrimh.gov.in/antiragging.html>), or from the Google Play Store by searching for "Anti-Ragging" or "MHRD Anti-Ragging App."

A student seeking admission to a Hostel shall submit additional affidavits on the date of hostel admission.

General Instructions

- The Admission Counselling Committee (ACC) will examine the requirements for counselling and admission upon the declaration of results by Gauhati University. The final selection of candidates for all courses will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of Gauhati University.
- Candidates are advised to visit the LGBRIMH website (www.lgbrimh.gov.in) and the GU portal (<https://admissions.gauhati.ac.in/>) regularly for updates.
- Candidates must submit a downloaded online application form (already submitted to Gauhati University) on the date of counselling for verification.
- Candidates must produce GU-PGET 2026 / GURET-2026 Admit Card on the date of counselling for verification.
- Candidates must produce all certificates and mark sheets including caste/class/tribe and experience certificate in original on the day of counselling. OBC (NCL) certificate must be in Central Govt. format. Failure to produce documents shall result in rejection of candidature.

Original documents shall be produced for verification and returned after verification unless retention is specifically authorized by applicable rules or written order of the competent authority. The Institute may retain self-attested copies and undertakings.

- High School / Higher Secondary Certificate / Birth Certificate as proof of date of birth.
- Employees of State or Central Government claiming NER quota reservation must produce a NOC or letter of award of deputation/sponsorship from the employer at the time of counselling.
- The cut-off date for determining eligibility criteria is the closing date for submission of online application form.
- The decision of the Admission Counselling Committee shall be final in all matters of selection.
- The period of training/course of study is full-time. Candidates are strictly prohibited from undergoing any other part-time or correspondence course during the period of training/course of study.
- All admitted candidates shall maintain good conduct, attend clinical work, academics and research regularly, and abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute/Hostel.
- Selected candidates shall submit Migration Certificate and Transfer Certificate at the time of admission/joining.
- Candidates allotted seats must carry a valid Photo ID (PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID Card, Passport or Aadhaar Card) at the time of admission.

On request, hostel accommodation will be provided to admitted scholars/trainees subject to availability of vacancy. Hostel allotment shall be regulated through a notified policy covering allotment priority, charges, mess rules, safety/security, grievance contact, disability accommodation and consequences of rule violation.

- Violation of hostel rules will result in immediate cancellation of allotment.
- After completion of the course, scholars/trainees will have to vacate the hostel room within 7 days. Failing which, license fee will be charged at ten times the rate of normal license fee.
