Senior Resident (Psychiatry) – Wellcome Trust-funded “HEADS” Research Project

Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH), Tezpur, an Autonomous Institute under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, invites applications from eligible and interested Indian nationals for engagement of **Senior Residents (Psychiatry)** on a **purely contractual and temporary basis** under the multi-centric research project “HEADS – Human-in-the-loop Evaluation of Assisted Depression Screening”, funded by the **Wellcome Trust, United Kingdom**. The engagement shall be co-terminus with the project and governed by the terms of the approved project budget and the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) among the participating institutions.

3. QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

A. Essential Qualifications

- Academic:** MBBS degree and a Postgraduate Degree/Diploma in Psychiatry (MD / DNB / Diploma in Psychological Medicine or equivalent Diploma in Psychiatry) from a University/Institution recognised by the National Medical Commission (NMC) / National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS).
- Registration:** Valid registration with the National Medical Commission (NMC) or a State Medical Council. The registration must be valid on the last date of receipt of applications and at the time of joining.
- DNB candidates:** Verification/equivalence of the DNB qualification by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences shall be as per the prevailing rules and notifications in force.

B. Desirable Qualifications

- (a) Proficiency in speaking, reading and writing Assamese and/or Bengali - this is considered crucial for local patient recruitment, clinical interviewing and data collection at the Tezpur site.
- (b) Experience in psychiatric interviewing and clinical research.
- (c) Experience in the administration of structured and semi-structured instruments such as QuickSCID-5 and PHQ-9.
- (d) Experience in digital data collection, handling of audio recordings, and redaction/de-identification of recorded data.
- (e) Experience in clinical reasoning annotation and quality control of transcripts and translations.

4. NATURE OF WORK / JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

The selected Senior Residents shall work under the supervision of the Site Principal Investigator at LGBRIMH and shall be required, inter alia, to:

- Conduct structured psychiatric assessments and clinical interviews of study participants using standardised tools, including **QuickSCID-5** and **PHQ-9**, in accordance with the approved study protocol.
- Undertake audio-recording of clinical interviews and ensure the secure storage, handling, transfer and de-identification of all participant interview data, as per the project's data management plan.
- Carry out diagnostic and clinical reasoning annotation of recorded interviews, and perform quality control of Assamese/Bengali transcriptions and their translations.
- Participate in inter-rater reliability and harmonisation exercises, multi-centric research meetings (physical/virtual), and training programmes organised by the lead and partner institutions.
- Contribute clinical inputs to the multidisciplinary AI development and evaluation pipeline in collaboration with the teams at NIMHANS, Bengaluru and IIT Kharagpur.
- Maintain study records, case report forms and documentation, and perform any other project-related duties assigned by the Principal Investigator from time to time.

5. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Nature of engagement:** The post is purely contractual, temporary and project-funded. The engagement shall be co-terminus with the project and **shall not confer any right or claim for regular appointment, absorption or continuation** in LGBRIMH or in any other project/post of the Institute.
2. **Full-time commitment:** The Senior Residents shall work exclusively and full-time for the HEADS project. They shall not be deputed or assigned to any non-project duties of the Institute. Private practice of any kind is not permitted during the tenure.

3. **Continuing Professional Development (CPD):** As mandated by the funding agency, a provision of **10 (ten) days per year** shall be available to each appointee for approved Continuing Professional Development activities.
4. **Confidentiality, data security and ethics:** Appointees shall strictly maintain the confidentiality and privacy of all participants and project data, comply with the approved study protocol, Institutional Ethics Committee conditions, ICMR National Ethical Guidelines, the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, and the data governance requirements of the funder and the MoU, and shall be required to execute a confidentiality/non-disclosure undertaking at the time of joining. Any breach shall lead to immediate termination, without prejudice to any other action under law.
5. **Termination:** The engagement may be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice or payment of one month's consolidated emoluments in lieu thereof. The Institute reserves the right to terminate the engagement without notice in case of unsatisfactory performance, misconduct, or closure/curtailment of the project or its funding.
6. **Continuation:** Extension beyond the initial period of one year shall be subject to periodic performance review, project requirements and availability of funds from the funding agency.
7. **No Objection Certificate:** Candidates presently employed in Central/State Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Bodies must submit a **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** from their employer at the time of interview, failing which they shall not be allowed to appear.
8. **TA/DA:** No Travelling Allowance / Dearness Allowance shall be paid for appearing in the interview.
9. **Accommodation:** Residential accommodation on the campus may be provided subject to availability and on payment of charges as per Institute rules; it cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
10. **Leave:** Leave shall be regulated as per the rules applicable to contractual/project staff of the Institute and the conditions of the project sanction.
11. **Eligibility cut-off:** All eligibility conditions (qualification, registration, age and experience) shall be reckoned as on the last date of receipt of applications.
12. **Screening:** Mere fulfilment of the eligibility criteria does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. The Institute may shortlist candidates on the basis of qualifications, experience and desirable attributes. Only shortlisted candidates shall be informed by e-mail.
13. **Documents:** Incomplete applications, or applications received after the last date, shall be summarily rejected. Selected candidates must produce all original documents for verification at the time of joining; the candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage if any information is found false or incorrect.
14. **Canvassing:** Canvassing in any form shall render the candidate disqualified.
15. **Right to amend:** The Director, LGBRIMH reserves the right to cancel, modify or restrict the recruitment process, or to fill or not to fill any or all of the posts, without assigning any reason. The decision of the Director in all matters shall be final and binding.

16. Jurisdiction: Any dispute arising out of this advertisement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts at Tezpur, Assam only.
